Greetings everyone. I am sorry that I am unable to be with you today, as I am out of state at a wedding. Thank you to Deborah C., 2023 Convention Chair, for presenting my report. It was a great honor serving as your 2022 CT AFG Convention Chair. We had an absolutely awesome committee and it was inspiring to see Concept 4, Participation is the Key to Harmony, in action throughout the process. I am grateful for having Deborah as my Co-Chair and for our wonderful committee and their service to this fellowship.

The final count of the number of registrants for the 44th CT AFG Convention, Where HOPE Grows-MIRACLES Bloom, was 420. The convention was held virtually on Zoom and was a one-day event. Registrants were from seven different countries- Bermuda, Canada, Ireland, Mexico, Poland, United Kingdom, and the United States. Twenty-five states were represented and one Canadian Province. It was a great turnout and an increased number of countries were represented this year on Zoom.
