Happy fall! I'm grateful to be here and serving as your Area Archives Coordinator. Over the last year, I have been working on a few things. I continue to attend events that Archives is invited to. This year, so far, I have attended three AA events; Round Up, Rompiendo Frontières / Breaking Fronters, and the AA Area convention, as well as the CT AFG Area convention and Spring assembly. I will also be attending the CT State Convention of Young People in AA (CSCYPAA) at the end of this month.

I have also attended two meetings hosted by WSO Archives which are held quarterly. At these meetings Archives coordinators from every area are invited to learn about the WSO's Archives as well as discuss how areas are managing their archives.
