

Area Public Outreach Report September 2020

The focus of Public Outreach is to provide our communities and those who are suffering from the effects of a loved one's drinking with Al-Anon/Alateen information.

Area Public Outreach continues to evolve and is researching new avenues to reach those in our communities.

- **Digital** The use of digital newspapers has increased significantly, growing from 2.6 million to 6 million in one month. PO is researching opportunities with Hearst Media, WTNH and Spodify to display the Al-Anon website and helpline information through display ads, banner rolls and live stream.
- **<u>Publications</u>** the Al-Anon website and helpline will be published quarterly in the Connecticut Academy of Physicians Assistants Newsletter.

September is National Recovery Month, a wonderful time for Districts to post Al-Anon information in their local online newspaper or local hometown newspapers. Please remember to follow the <u>Important posting guidelines</u>:

- Inform your District PO Coordinator, Alternate DR or DR.
- Remain anonymous.
- Use conference approved literature.
